Debus (recorder) Tabea is much sought after as a soloist, collaborator, teacher and communicator. Elizabeth Kenny, one of Europe's leading Lute players, is Director of Performance at Oxford University and professor of Lute at the Royal Academy. Jonathan Rees (viola da gamba) performs widely; his



quest appearances include ENO, Britten Sinfonia, OAE and AAM.

The Carducci String Quartet - Described by the 'Strad' as presenting 'a masterclass in unanimity of musical purpose, in which severity could melt seamlessly into charm, and drama into geniality' the awardwinning Carducci Quartet is internationally acclaimed as one of the most accomplished and versatile ensembles of today.
