



Richard Jenkinson and Benjamin Frith, both distinguished soloists in their own right, have given many recitals throughout the UK. Their repertoire takes in everything from the great classics to contemporary works.



Travelling by Tuba is a unique group who performs stunning innovative programmes. As one of the busiest groups in the U.K. they undertook over 200 performances last year. This success was not only due to their virtuosic performance but also the ability as irrepressible entertainers to communicate with their audience.



Acclaimed duo, **Eleanor Percy & Irina Lyakhovskaya** have been performing recitals together for 12 years, in leading concert halls across Europe. Their discography includes sonatas by Brahms, Prokofiev and complete Mozart sonatas for the Melodiya label.



The King Clarinet Trio takes its name from the renowned clarinettist the late Dame Thea King. They have all performed concerti for their instrument with a great variety of orchestras throughout United Kingdom, Europe, Asia, and both North and South America.



The Eberle Quartet is recognised for its high quality performances and immediate rapport with audiences. Recital repertoire encompasses the Classical era, the Romantic giants, 20th century Greats, light classical and also 21st century living composers who have written works with the Eberle in mind.
